All Seasons Architectural Windows began as ALENCO, founded shortly after World War II by Ford D. Albritton, Jr. who grew this business to be the largest aluminum window and door manufacturing operation in the U.S. In 1968 ALENCO was sold to Redman Building Products Inc. Production continued as ALENCO Commercial Division until 1999, when Bill Akins purchased the Commercial Division to expand his residential window business. With this acquisition, ALENCO Commercial became All Seasons Commercial Windows and the name was later changed to All Seasons Architectural Windows.
